Out of my Mind

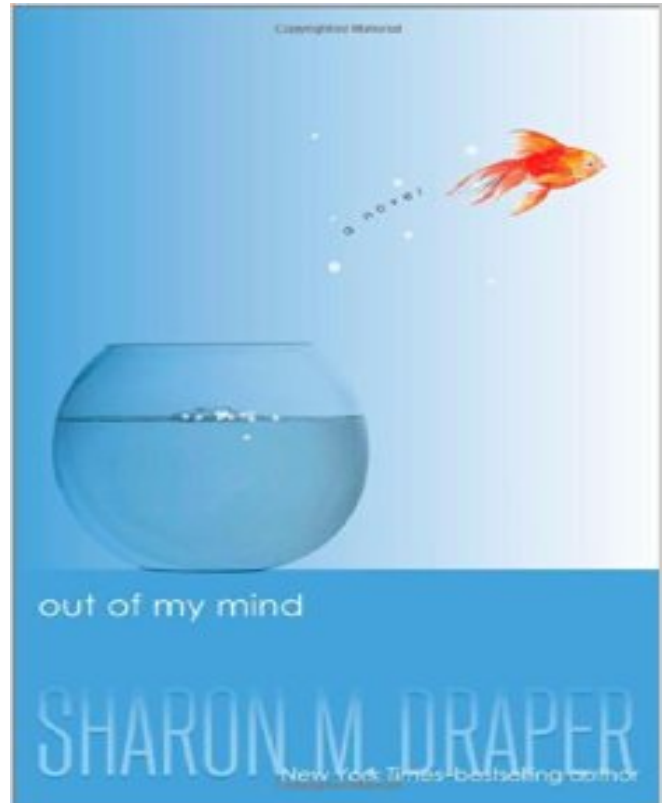
